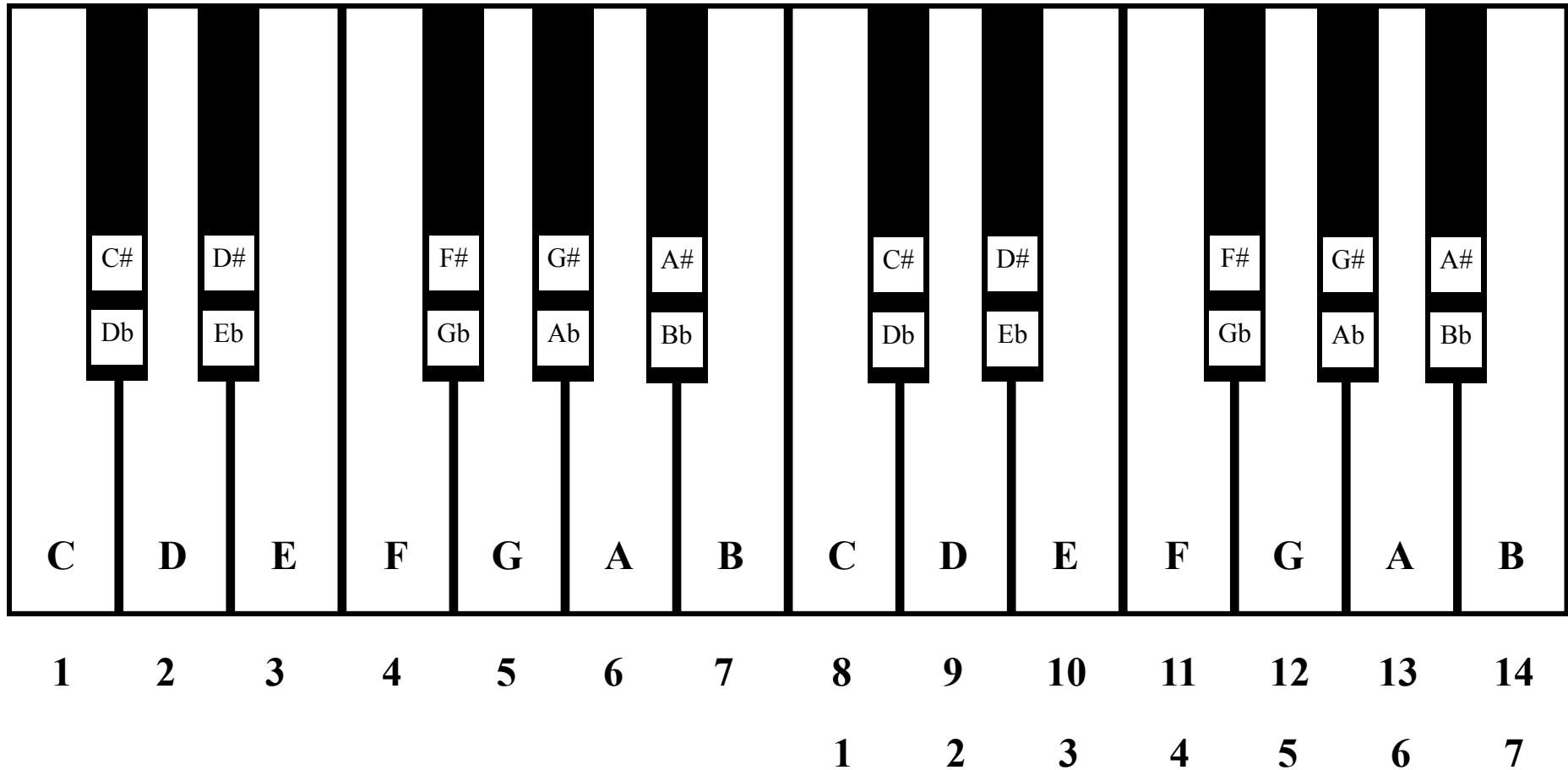


The Notes Of The Piano Keyboard



Each consecutive note on the piano keyboard is a **semitone** away from its neighbour. A semitone is an **interval** or distance like half an inch. A distance or interval of two semitones is called a **tone**.

If you choose any note and then play seven other notes in ascending order using the following intervals, you will always produce the **major scale**: Tone-Tone-Semitone-Tone-Tone-Tone-Semitone. Good eh!
